## JPBA Guidelines for Prevention of the Spread of New Coronavirus Infections 2022 Revised August 2022 (latest overseas version)

## (1) [Before the tournament] (Cancellation policy)

- If your body temperature is 37.5 degrees Celsius or higher on the day before or on the day of the tournament, please withdraw from the tournament.
- If you have symptoms similar to a cold, such as a cough or sore throat, or if you experience changes in your sense of smell or taste, or if you feel heavy, sluggish, tired, or have difficulty breathing, please withdraw from the tournament.
- If you have been in close contact with a person who has tested positive for novel coronavirus infection by PCR test within 5 days prior to the match, please withdraw from the competition. (\*Except for those who themselves have a negative PCR test result (certificate required) up to the day before the match.
- Those who have been in close contact with a family member or relative who is suspected to have tested positive within 5 days prior to the match are requested to withdraw from the tournament. \*Excluding those who themselves have a negative PCR test result (certificate required) up to the day before the match.
- If you have any of the above conditions, please send us an e-mail immediately declining to participate in the tournament.

## [During the tournament game]

- Please take your temperature and sanitize your hands as soon as you enter.
- Wear a mask \*You may not compete without wearing a mask. (Please make sure that your mouth and nose are covered.)
- Please make sure to use your own chalk and keep it off the table when you turn.
- Please do not shake hands, but only bail or give a "g-touch" when banking.
- Please maintain a social distance (2m or more) while waiting in the hall and during the game.
- Please wash your hands frequently in the venue.
- If you feel sick, please notify the management staff.
- Please do not make loud noises.

## (2) [After the game

If you test positive for the new coronavirus infection by PCR test within 3 days after the match, please contact the JPBA Head Office.
